Since 1991, the nonprofit, [Friends of the Riverfront](#), has been active in the environmental protection and restoration of the 33 miles of riverfront along Pittsburgh’s three rivers. Known as the Three Rivers Heritage Trail, a spring clean-up of the riverfront is conducted each year to get the trail ready for trail users. The public is invited to join in this clean-up mission.
